#### **New Staff Position: Minister of Mission and Outreach**

More than 20 years ago, Christ Lutheran Church committed to serving our San Antonio community and beyond by sending 20% of all our offerings to non-profit benevolence ministries outside our walls. We have maintained that commitment through all the challenges of recent decades, including the worldwide pandemic. Lives have been changed with those dollars as unhoused persons and families, teen mothers, immigrants, refugees, and impoverished persons in need of hospice ministries have found shelter and care.

Two generous designated gifts will help us build on our 20% benevolence tradition, completely funding the first year of a new part-time Minister for Mission and Outreach. Elward Reiss offered a gift in memory of her beloved husband, Bernie Reiss, and another generous donor, who prefers to remain anonymous, covered the remainder. Their generosity provides initial support toward realizing our dream of having a staff person dedicated to connecting us more fully to those in need outside our congregation.

CLC's clergy and Congregation Council stand exuberantly and unanimously behind creation of this new position, fully committed to funding the Minister of Mission and Outreach for the long term. Though the budgetary impact may be modest, the harvest will far outweigh the dollars spent. This ministry will connect us to recipients/benevolence partners in concrete, measurable ways, enhancing reporting and accountability in serving those most vulnerable. We are seeking an effective leader to guide the congregation to spread the gospel message of God's love through witness and service in our community. - Coordinate the planning and implementation of a comprehensive ministry for involving the congregation in mission, advocacy, and outreach.
- Develop a year-round program of outreach education for all ages, so the congregation will be better informed and strongly committed to supporting the mission of making disciples for the transformation of the world.
- Link with organizations, people, and resources in and beyond the congregation that are concerned with mission, outreach, and advocacy, especially our benevolence partners.
- Guide the congregation in worship and fellowship that highlight mission, outreach, and advocacy.

#### **Education and Experience:**

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- Three years' experience in ministry, whether in a volunteer or paid position, is preferred.

#### Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Possess one or more of these spiritual gifts: servanthood, exhortation (encouragement), leadership, compassion, faith, administration, helping, and evangelism.
- Demonstrate evidence of passion for active service and helping others engage in ministry in the world.
- Display passion for responding to the hurts and needs of people in the congregation, community, and the world.
- Ability to listen to and communicate with people of all ages.
- Genuine interest in mission and outreach in the community and the world.
- Openness to new views and different people.
- Creativity in developing ways to interpret and support mission.
- Ability to work with volunteers of various skill levels.
